

WHAT IS DERBY?

Modern flat-track all-female roller derby is a grassroots effort, self organized & self run. Derby leagues have popped up all over the globe with over 160 WFTDA member leagues and 87 apprentice leagues worldwide. There are 9 leagues in the state of Alaska. Most leagues are non-profits or LLC's and skate under the WFTDA standardized flat track roller derby rules and regulations.

Roller Derby is an aggressive, full contact athletic sport that continues to grow in popularity worldwide. Two teams of 5 play at a time, with 4 blockers and 1 jammer each. The jammers try to get through the pack, and on their second pass through score one point for each opposing player passed. The blockers play both offense and defense, either assisting their jammer or blocking the other jammer.




